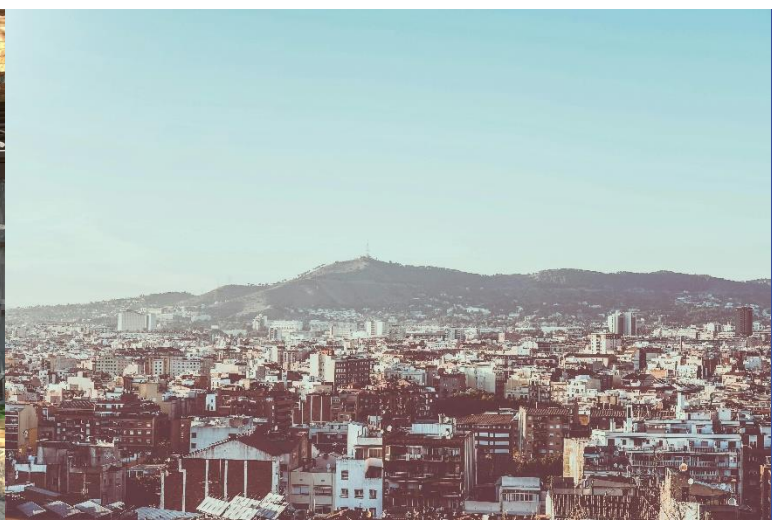

### **Barcelona Meeting Drives Project Development**

On October 21, 2025, the partners of the CODE Project gathered in Barcelona for a productive and inspiring transnational meeting hosted at the facilities of the Trinijove Foundation. The event marked an important milestone in the project's development, following the testing activities carried out during September 2025.

Representatives from Clerici, Trinijove, Atlantis, Istituto dei Sordi di Torino, Chambre de Commerce Italienne de Nice, CB, Irsam, and Online People First took part in the meeting, reinforcing the project's collaborative and European dimension.

The meeting provided an opportunity to review the piloting phase and current progress, discuss the training course work package, and evaluate the digital platform and training materials developed by the Atlantis team. Participants also addressed administrative, dissemination, and quality assurance aspects, and exchanged feedback on training use cases and integration strategies.



A special moment was the interview conducted by Radio Trinijove, which gave visibility to the project's goals of inclusion and accessibility within the financial sector.



## A Day Dedicated to Inclusive Financial Empowerment

The day began with a warm welcome and a guided visit to Trinijove's training and recycling centers, highlighting the foundation's strong social commitment.

In the afternoon, the working sessions focused on refining educational tools based on the principles of Universal Design, ensuring that financial services and learning resources are accessible to persons with disabilities.



The partners reaffirmed their shared mission to promote financial independence and raise awareness among SMEs and financial institutions about the importance of inclusive practices.

The meeting concluded with a roundtable discussion on next steps, defining a clear roadmap for the upcoming phases of the CODE project, continuing to work together to make financial inclusion a reality for everyone.
